A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to the Wyoming national guard and the
2 emergency management assistance compact; providing for the
3 repeal of prohibitions on national guard forces being under
4 arms or being assigned to law enforcement missions while
5 serving in another state; and providing for an effective
6 date.

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8 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

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10 **Section 1.** W.S. 19-9-209(b)(i) and 19-13-402(c) are
11 amended to read:

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13 **19-9-209. Service in state; active duty status**
14 **outside of state; costs to state.**

16 (b) Members ordered into state active duty pursuant

1 to subsection (a) of this section shall:

3 (i) Receive the same pay and allowances as
4 though their service is within this state; and

6 **19-13-402. Purposes and authorities.**

8 (c) This compact shall also provide for mutual
9 cooperation in emergency-related exercises, testing or other
10 training activities using equipment and personnel simulating
11 performance of any aspect of the giving and receiving of aid
12 by party states or subdivisions of party states during
13 emergencies for actions occurring outside actual declared
14 emergency periods. Mutual assistance in this compact may
15 include the use of the states' national guard forces, either
16 in accordance with the National Guard Mutual Assistance
17 Compact or by mutual agreement between states. ~~., provided~~
18 ~~however, mutual assistance or cooperation shall be limited~~
19 ~~to civil uses essential to the safety, care and welfare of~~
20 ~~the people and shall not include a request for or response~~
21 ~~by national guard forces under arms.~~

23 **Section 2.** W.S. 19-9-209(b)(ii) is repealed.
