for

1 AN ACT relating to public schools; requiring school
2 districts to permit students to possess and self-administer
3 epinephrine self injection medication; imposing
4 requirements; delegating duties to the department of
5 education; and providing for an effective date.

7 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

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9 **Section 1.** W.S. 21-4-310(a) and (c) is amended to
10 read:

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12 **21-4-310. Self-administration of asthma and**
13 **epinephrine self injection medication.**

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15 (a) The district board shall permit a student to
16 possess and self-administer asthma or epinephrine self

1 injection medication within any school of the district if a
2 written statement is submitted to the district containing
3 applicable:

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5 (i) Parental verification that the student is
6 responsible for and capable of self-administration and
7 parental authorization for self-administration of asthma or
8 epinephrine self injection medication;

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10 (ii) Health care provider identification of the
11 prescribed or authorized asthma or epinephrine self
12 injection medication and verification of the
13 appropriateness of the student's possession and self-
14 administration of the asthma or epinephrine self injection
15 medication.

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19 (i) "Asthma medication" means prescription or
20 nonprescription inhaled asthma medication;i

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22 (ii) "Epinephrine self injection medication"
23 means prescription single dose epinephrine pens.
