A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to administration of the government;
2 expanding the duties of the advisory council on aging;
3 providing an appropriation; and providing for an effective
4 date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

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8 **Section 1.** W.S. 9-2-1207 by creating a new subsection
9 (f) is amended to read:

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11 **9-2-1207. State advisory council; officers; meetings;**
12 **quorum; records; expenses; duties.**

14 (f) In addition to any other duties prescribed by law
15 the advisory council on aging shall advise the division on
16 aging on long term care issues including, but not limited

1 to, assisted living, adult day care, boarding homes, home
2 health agencies, hospice care, hospital care, nursing care
3 and personal care for the aging.

5 **Section 2.** Eighteen thousand five hundred dollars
6 (\$18,500.00) is appropriated from the general fund and
7 eighteen thousand five hundred dollars (\$18,500.00) in
8 federal funds to the department of health for the period
9 ending June 30, 2008, for the cost of reimbursing nonstate
10 employed members of the advisory council on aging for
11 necessary expenses incurred in the performance of council
12 duties.

14 **Section 3.** This act is effective July 1, 2007.
