A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to physicians assistants; specifying the
2 number of physician assistants a licensed physician may
3 supervise; and providing for an effective date.

5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7 **Section 1.** W.S. 33-26-504(f) is amended to read:

9 **33-26-504. License required; application;**
10 **qualifications; consideration of applications.**

12 (f) The board, with the concurrence of the advisory
13 committee, shall approve an application by a licensed
14 physician to supervise physician assistants if the board is
15 satisfied that each proposed physician assistant is a
16 graduate of an approved program, has satisfactorily

1 completed a certification examination and is fully
2 qualified to assist in the practice of medicine under the
3 responsible supervision of a licensed physician. It shall
4 be the policy of the board to allow at least ~~three (3)~~ four
5 (4) physician assistants per physician and the board and
6 the advisory committee shall not deny an application due to
7 the number of physician assistants supervised up to at
8 least ~~three (3)~~ four (4), except for good cause specific to
9 the circumstances of that individual physician.

11 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2007.
