A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to game and fish violations; providing
2 additional penalties for hunting when hunting privileges
3 have been revoked or suspended; extending penalties; and
4 providing for an effective date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 23-6-206(a)(intro), (b), by creating
9 new subsections (c) and (d) and by renumbering (c) as (e)
10 is amended to read:

12 **23-6-206. Revocation of license; hunting after**
13 **suspended license.**

14

15 (a) The court may, in its discretion, revoke any
16 license issued under this act to any person convicted of a

1 violation of this act, for the remainder of the year in
2 which the conviction occurs, and except for conviction of a
3 10th or 11th degree misdemeanor, may suspend the person's
4 privilege to purchase or receive any other license under
5 this act, or to take any wildlife for the following time
6 periods:

8 (b) No person whose license has been forfeited or
9 privilege to purchase another license suspended shall
10 procure, purchase, or possess another license during the
11 period of forfeiture or suspension. If the person
12 procures, purchases, or possesses another license during
13 such period, the license is invalid and that person is not
14 entitled to receive another license for ~~the year~~ up to six
15 (6) years next succeeding the ~~year in which a conviction of~~
16 ~~a violation of this subsection occurs~~ original revocation
17 or suspension period. Violation of this subsection
18 constitutes a ~~9th~~ 5th degree misdemeanor.

19
20 (c) No person whose license has been forfeited or
21 privilege to purchase another license suspended shall take
22 any wildlife prohibited by the court during the period of
23 forfeiture or suspension. If the person takes any wildlife
24 prohibited by the court during such period, that person is

1 not entitled to receive another license for up to six (6)
2 years next succeeding the original revocation or suspension
3 period. Violation of this subsection constitutes a 5th
4 degree misdemeanor.

6 (d) If a probation period is imposed for any offense
7 under this act, the person placed on probation shall not
8 purchase or receive any license or take any wildlife
9 prohibited by the court until all fines, costs and
10 restitution imposed by the court are satisfied. Any person
11 who violates this subsection shall be punished pursuant to
12 subsection (c) of this section.

14 ~~(e)~~(e) "Conviction" means a determination of guilt by
15 any Wyoming court having legal jurisdiction of the offense
16 from which no appeal is legally perfected. Pleas of nolo
17 contendere and forfeitures of bail shall be deemed
18 convictions for the purposes of this act.

19
20 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2007.
