A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to motor vehicle license plates;  
2 authorizing special license plates to be issued to  
3 emergency medical technicians; specifying requirements; and  
4 providing for an effective date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 31-2-219 is created to read:

9

10 **31-2-219. Emergency medical technician's license**  
11 **plates.**

13 (a) Any person certified by the department of health  
14 as an emergency medical technician may apply for  
15 distinctive license plates for any motor vehicle owned by  
16 that person upon registration of the vehicle. These license

1 plates shall be displayed upon the vehicle for which they  
2 are issued. The license plates shall bear a distinctive  
3 symbol and letters identifying the registrant as an  
4 emergency medical technician.

5  
6 (b) Application for license plates under subsection  
7 (a) of this section shall be annually made to the county  
8 treasurer as provided by W.S. 31-2-201. A written statement  
9 of eligibility, accompanied by a copy of the applicant's  
10 current emergency medical technician certification, shall  
11 be presented to the county treasurer before a license plate  
12 may be issued. Application forms shall be available at all  
13 county treasurer's offices. The normal registration fees  
14 and the fee required under W.S. 31-3-102(a)(viii) shall  
15 accompany each application.

16  
17 (c) All applications for special license plates  
18 provided by this section shall be made directly to the  
19 county treasurer at least thirty (30) days before  
20 registration of the vehicle expires. The department may  
21 prepare any special forms and issue any rules and  
22 regulations necessary to carry out this section.

1           (d) The special license plates shall be the same size  
2 and color as regular motor vehicle license plates but shall  
3 be designed so as to indicate that the owner of the motor  
4 vehicle is an emergency medical technician and need not  
5 include arabic numerals for the county.

7           **Section 2.** This act is effective January 1, 2007.
