School bus driver's-hours of operation.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to school districts; imposing maximum
2 driving times for school bus operators; and providing for
3 an effective date.

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5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

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7 **Section 1.** W.S. 21-3-131 by creating a new subsection
8 (c) is amended to read:

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10 **21-3-131. School bus standards; operators; vehicle**
11 **operation; maximum driving times.**

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13 (c) Each district shall establish and enforce maximum
14 driving times for school bus operators which shall include
15 school bus operations transporting students to and from
16 school and to and from school activities. The maximum

1 driving times shall not permit or require any school bus
2 operator to operate a school bus:

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4 (i) More than ten (10) hours following
5 eight (8) consecutive hours of off duty time; or

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7 (ii) For any period of time after fifteen
8 (15) hours of on duty time following eight (8) consecutive
9 hours of off duty time; and

11 (iii) For any period of time after:

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13 (A) Having been on duty for sixty (60)
14 hours in any seven (7) consecutive day period if the school
15 bus operator is not employed to operate school buses every
16 day of the week school is in session; or

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18 (B) Having been on duty for seventy
19 (70) hours in any eight (8) consecutive day period if the
20 school bus operator is employed to operate school buses
21 every day of the week school is in session.

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
