A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to game and fish; providing for felony
2 convictions for second or subsequent violations as
3 specified; providing penalties; and providing for an
4 effective date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 23-3-102(d) and 23-3-107(d) are
9 amended to read:

10

11 **23-3-102. Taking certain game animals without license**
12 **or during a closed season prohibited.**

13

14 (d) Any person who knowingly takes any antlered elk,
15 antlered deer, antlered moose, horned antelope, bighorn
16 sheep, mountain goat, mountain lion, grizzly bear or black

1 bear without the proper license or during a closed season
2 except as otherwise permitted by this act is guilty of a
3 misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not less than five
4 thousand dollars (\$5,000.00) nor more than ten thousand
5 dollars (\$10,000.00), imprisonment for not more than one
6 (1) year, or both. A second or subsequent conviction

7 within ten (10) years for a violation of this subsection
8 constitutes a felony punishable by a fine of not less than
9 five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00) nor more than ten
10 thousand dollars (\$10,000.00), imprisonment for not more
11 than ten (10) years, or both.

13 **23-3-107. Wanton destruction of big game animal;**
14 **reward.**

16 (d) Violation of this section constitutes a 1st
17 degree misdemeanor. A second or subsequent conviction
18 within ten (10) years for a violation of this section
19 constitutes a felony punishable by a fine of not more than
20 ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00), imprisonment for not
21 more than ten (10) years, or both.
