A BILL

For

1 AN ACT relating to municipalities; providing for conducting
2 and filing of survey or perambulations of boundaries upon
3 annexation; providing for filing of notice of survey with
4 all special districts affected by annexation; modifying
5 time of notice; and providing for an effective date.

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7 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

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9 **Section 1.** W.S. 15-1-413(a), (c)(intro) and (ii) is
10 amended to read:

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12 **15-1-413. Survey or perambulation of boundaries; when**
13 **and how to be made; presumption once recorded.**

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15 (a) If the boundaries of any city or town are
16 uncertain or incapable of ascertainment and upon the change

1 in boundaries of any city or town pursuant to any
2 annexation under this chapter, the governing body, by
3 ordinance, ~~may~~shall provide for a survey or perambulation
4 thereof. ~~if~~When the survey or perambulation is made, the
5 boundaries shall be marked by substantial monuments, and
6 the person making the survey shall report to the governing
7 body describing the boundaries by metes and bounds. The
8 description as nearly as possible shall refer, if upon
9 surveyed lands, to the corners or lines of the United
10 States surveys. The person making the survey shall also
11 file with the city or town clerk the field notes of his
12 survey. The city or town clerk shall then file a copy of
13 the report and a copy of the field notes certified by the
14 mayor and clerk with the county clerk for the county in
15 which the city or town is located.

17 (c) The city or town clerk shall file a copy of an
18 official map or legal description designating the
19 geographical boundaries of the city or town or the changes
20 to its geographical boundaries with the department of
21 revenue, the county assessor and the county clerk in the
22 county or counties within which the city or town is located
23 in accordance with the department's rules adopted pursuant
24 to W.S. 39-11-102(c)(xxiv) regarding tax districts, with

1 any special district affected by the boundary change and as
2 follows:

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4 (ii) ~~Annually, by a date determined by the~~
5 ~~department,~~ Within thirty (30) days if a city or town has
6 changes to its geographical boundaries by annexation or de-
7 annexation. ~~in the preceding year.~~

9 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2007.
