Community colleges-capital construction.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to community colleges; providing
2 appropriations for certain capital construction projects as
3 specified; and providing for an effective date.

5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7 **Section 1.**

8

9 (a) There is appropriated from the general fund to
10 the Wyoming community college commission the following
11 amounts for expenditure for the capital construction
12 projects listed:

13

14 (i) Four hundred forty-eight thousand one
15 hundred ninety-five dollars (\$448,195.00) for the

1 veterinarian technology building at eastern Wyoming
2 college;

4 (ii) Eighteen million three hundred ninety-four
5 thousand dollars (\$18,394,000.00) for the technical
6 education center at northern Wyoming Community College,
7 Gillette college campus;

8

9 (iii) Seven million four hundred thirty-five
10 thousand seven hundred seventy-four dollars (\$7,435,774.00)
11 for the health science building at Laramie County Community
12 College.

13

14 (b) The funds appropriated in subsection (a) of this
15 section shall be retained by the commission and available
16 to the community college to fund the authorized project
17 only to the extent that funds are received from other
18 nongeneral fund sources, public or private, to match the
19 general fund appropriation dollar for dollar.

20

21 (c) Western Wyoming College is authorized to expend
22 not to exceed six million dollars (\$6,000,000.00) for a
23 dormitory residence hall. The funds shall be received from
24 nonstate general fund sources, public or private. At such

1 time as Western Wyoming College certifies to the Wyoming
2 community college commission that a sufficient amount of
3 funds have been received for the dormitory residence hall,
4 four million dollars (\$4,000,000.00) shall be appropriated
5 from the general fund to Western Wyoming College for the
6 diesel mechanics addition.

7

8 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2007.
