A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to water development projects; providing
2 for construction of dams and reservoirs; authorizing
3 construction of designated water projects; describing
4 projects; specifying terms and conditions of funding for
5 projects; providing appropriations; modifying project
6 descriptions and terms of appropriations for various
7 specified prior projects; amending the small water
8 development program as specified; and providing for an
9 effective date.

11 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

13 **Section 1.** W.S. 99-3-1201 through 99-3-1204 are

30 (a) Authorization is granted for the Level III new
31 development construction projects identified in this
32 section subject to the general conditions specified in W.S.
33 99-3-103.

20 construction of the project an amount not to exceed two
21 million one hundred forty-four thousand dollars
22 (\$2,144,000.00) or sixty-seven percent (67%) of the actual
23 development costs, whichever is less;

25 (vi) Project loan: The state of Wyoming shall
26 loan to the sponsor from water development account I
27 through the commission for the design, permit procurement,
28 construction engineering, project land procurement and
