1 AN ACT relating to administration of the government;
2 amending requirements for reports due to the joint revenue
3 interim committee; repealing outdated reporting
4 requirements; and providing for an effective date.

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6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

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8 **Section 1.** 39-15-105 by creating a new subsection
9 (b), 39-16-105 by creating a new subsection (b) and
10 39-17-109(d)(v) are amended to read:

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12 **39-15-105. Exemptions.**

13 (b) The Wyoming business council and the department
14 of revenue shall jointly report on or before December 1 of

1 each year that the exemption provided by subparagraph (O)
2 or (R) of paragraph (viii) of subsection (a) of this
3 section is in effect to the joint revenue interim
4 committee. The report shall evaluate the cumulative
5 effects of each exemption that is in effect from initiation
6 of the exemption and shall include:

8 (i) A history of employment in terms of numbers
9 of employees, full-time and part-time employees and rates
10 of turnover;

11
12 (ii) A history of wages and benefits
13 disaggregated by gender for each job category; and

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15 (iii) A comprehensive history of taxes paid to
16 the state of Wyoming.

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18 **39-16-105. Exemptions.**

19 (b) The Wyoming business council and the department
20 of revenue shall jointly report on or before December 1 of
21 each year that the exemption provided by subparagraph (D)
22 or (G) of paragraph (viii) of subsection (a) of this
23 section is in effect to the joint revenue interim

1 committee. The report shall evaluate the cumulative
2 effects of each exemption that is in effect from initiation
3 of the exemption and shall include:

5 (i) A history of employment in terms of numbers
6 of employees, full-time and part-time employees and rates
7 of turnover;

9 (ii) A history of wages and benefits
10 disaggregated by gender for each job category; and

12 (iii) A comprehensive history of taxes paid to
13 the state of Wyoming.

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15 **39-17-109. Taxpayer remedies.**

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17 (d) Credits. The following shall apply:

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19 (v) No later than ~~January 1, 2002,~~ January 1 of
20 each year, the department, in consultation with the
21 department of administration and information, shall submit
22 a report to the joint transportation and highways interim
23 committee and the joint revenue interim committee. The

1 report shall provide information with respect to the
2 economic benefits of the ethanol credit voucher program
3 created under this subsection and the cost to the state for
4 the program;

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6 **Section 2.** W.S. 39-14-105(d) and 39-14-202(a)(ix) are
7 repealed.
