(e) Notwithstanding W.S. 31-7-131(c), if a driver's 1 2 license is reinstated after a period of suspension or revocation, the fee for the reinstatement shall be  $\frac{\text{fifty}}{\text{fifty}}$ 3 4 dollars (\$50.00) ninety dollars (\$90.00) unless the final 5 decision by the hearing examiner, or a court reverses the action taken by the department. If a driver's license is 6 reinstated after suspension for nonpayment of child support 7 pursuant to W.S. 20-6-111 or 20-6-112, the fee for 8 9 reinstatement shall be not more than five dollars (\$5.00). 10 31-8-104. Fees. 11 12 13 Every applicant for an identification card shall pay ten dollars (\$10.00) twenty dollars (\$20.00) to the department. 14 The state treasurer shall credit identification card fees 15 to the highway fund. 16 17 Section 2.
