Endowment fund 1 challenge matching 2 program; matching payments; agreements with foundations; 3 annual reports. 4 5 (j) Each community college shall on or before October 1 of each year submit a report from its foundation to the 6 7 state treasurer from its foundation and the community college commission on the endowment matching program under 8 9 this section for the preceding fiscal year. The report shall include a financial summary and a review of the 10 11 accomplishments resulting from endowment program 12 expenditures. The report required under this subsection 13 shall be for each applicable fiscal year through June 30, 14 2011. 15 16 21-18-202. In carrying out this paragraph 15 16 and maintaining the funding allocation model under 17 paragraph (c)(i) of this section: 18 19 The commission shall insure uniform (A) 20 accounting in recording full-time equivalent students and 21 reporting financial data; 22 23 (B) Each community college shall report 24 information to the commission in a uniform, consistent and

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2 regulation. 3 4 (v)(A) The commission shall provide 5 reports specifically requested and defined by to legislature or and governor on the performance performance 6 7 of individual community colleges and the combined colleges college system as well as on the achievement of any 8 9 statewide priorities as defined by the legislature and as 10 specified in the statewide college system strategic plan. 11 The commission and the colleges shall work together in a 12 collaborative effort in defining the report formats and the 13 methodology and data elements required in preparing each of 14 the reports and a reasonable time line for completion of 15 reports; 16 17 21-20-201. Agreement between districts and 18 postsecondary education institutions authorized; student 19 participation; credits; financial arrangements; 20 transportation; accessibility. 21 22 (a) A Wyoming school district board of trustees and a Wyoming community college district board of trustees or the 23 24 University of Wyoming may enter into an agreement

1 establish a postsecondary education enrollment options 2 program whereby students resident of the participating 3 district may attend postsecondary education programs 4 offered by the university or a participating community 5 college. Additional student eligibility requirements for program participation shall be 6 based upon criteria 7 established by the university or the community college in collaboration with the department of education, which 8 9 address the high school grade level, uniform prior curricula requirements, academic achievement levels and 10 11 national examination performance indicators. 12 13 **Section 2.** For the 2009-2010 biennium commencing July 14 2008, and ending June 30, 2010, two hundred fifty 15 thousand dollars (\$250,000.00) is appropriated from the 16 general fund to the Wyoming community college commission to 17 carry out this act. Of this amount, the commission shall 18 fund and is authorized one (1) additional full-time 19 position. 20 21 Section 3. This act is effective July 1, 2008. 22 23 (END)
