## A BILL

for

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8 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

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- Section 1. W.S. 42-4-120 by creating a new subsection
- 11 (g) is amended to read:

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- 16 (g) The department shall establish by rule and
- 17 regulation a cost based reimbursement system to pay

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2 (iii) Be developed following consultation with 3 Wyoming developmental disability and acquired brain injury 4 waiver program service providers, developmental disability 5 waiver program clients and their families and an expert in cost based waiver program payment systems, which the 6 7 department is authorized to retain by contract following 8 competitive bidding; 9 10 (iv) Be implemented for services and supplies 11 provided under individual budget amounts established on and after July 1, 2008; 12 13 14 (v) Be contingent upon approval by the center 15 for Medicare and Medicaid services of the United States 16 department of health and human services; 17 18 (vi) Require service and supply providers to 19 provide actual cost of service and supply data to the 20 department and to submit to reasonable audits of the 21 submitted data, if requested by the department. 22 Section 2. There is appropriated three million eight 23 24 hundred eighty-six thousand one hundred fifteen dollars

(\$3,886,115.00) from the general fund and three million 1 2 eight hundred eighty-six thousand one hundred fifteen 3 dollars (\$3,886,115.00) from federal funds to the 4 department of health. This appropriation shall be for the 5 period beginning with the effective date of this act and ending June 30, 2010. This appropriation shall only be 6 7 expended for the purpose of increases in payments to service providers under the cost based payment system 8 9 created by this act, and is in addition to other amounts appropriated for home and community based waiver programs. 10 11 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, this 12 appropriation shall not be transferred or expended for any 13 other purpose and any unexpended, unobligated 14 remaining from this appropriation shall revert as provided by law on July 1, 2010. This appropriation shall be 15 16 included in the department's 2011-2012 standard biennial 17 budget request.

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19 **Section 3.** This act is effective July 1, 2008.
