Temporary food events.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to public health and safety; modifying
2 license requirements and fees for temporary food events;
3 and providing for an effective date.

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5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

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7 **Section 1.** W.S. 35-7-124(b) is amended to read:

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9 **35-7-124. License required; exemptions; electronic**
10 **transmittals.**

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12 (b) Written application for a new license shall be
13 made on a form approved by the department of agriculture
14 and provided by the department of agriculture or the local
15 health department and shall be signed by the applicant. An
16 initial license fee of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) shall

1 accompany each application. The license fee for a temporary
2 food event license shall be twenty-five dollars (\$25.00)
3 ~~which event shall for a period~~ not to exceed fourteen (14)
4 days and shall be for one (1) location. The license fee for
5 an annual temporary food event license shall be fifty
6 dollars (\$50.00) and shall be a statewide license. License
7 requirements and fees for temporary food events operated by
8 nonprofit organizations shall be waived. Licenses shall
9 expire one (1) year after the date of issuance unless
10 suspended or revoked. Licenses may be renewed each year
11 upon application to the department or local health
12 department accompanied by a fee of fifty dollars (\$50.00).
13 Any establishment which has a license on the effective date
14 of this section shall pay a fee of fifty dollars (\$50.00)
15 for the following year and shall not be liable to pay the
16 initial license fee of one hundred dollars (\$100.00).

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18 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2008.
