A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to public funds; redirecting certain funds
2 to the Wyoming wildlife and natural resource trust account
3 as specified; and providing for an effective date.

5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7 **Section 1.** W.S. 9-4-713(b) is amended to read:

9 **9-4-713. Investment earnings spending policy -**
10 **permanent funds.**

12 (b) There is created the permanent Wyoming mineral
13 trust fund reserve account. Except as otherwise provided in
14 this subsection, as soon as possible after the end of each
15 of the fiscal years beginning on and after July 1, 2000,
16 revenues in this account in excess of seventy-five percent

1 (75%) of the spending policy amount in subsection (d) of
2 this section shall be credited to the permanent Wyoming
3 mineral trust fund. For the fiscal year ending June 30,
4 2008, fifty million dollars (\$50,000,000.00) in revenues in
5 this account in excess of seventy-five percent (75%) of the
6 spending policy amount in subsection (d) of this section
7 shall first be deposited to the Wyoming wildlife and
8 natural resource trust account created by W.S. 9-15-103(a).

9
10 **Section 2.** This act is effective immediately upon
11 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
12 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
13 Constitution.
