A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to regulation of motor vehicles on
2 highways; requiring headlights be used when a vehicle is in
3 operation upon a highway; and providing for an effective
4 date.

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6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

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8 **Section 1.** W.S. 31-5-910 is amended to read:

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10 **31-5-910. Lighted lamps and illuminating devices.**

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12 Every vehicle including those listed in W.S. 31-5-901(c),
13 except as otherwise provided in this act, upon a highway
14 within this state ~~at any time from one half (1/2) hour~~
15 ~~after sunset to one half (1/2) hour before sunrise and at~~
16 ~~any other time when, due to insufficient light or~~
17 ~~unfavorable atmospheric conditions, persons and vehicles on~~

1 ~~the highway are not clearly discernible at a distance of~~
2 ~~one thousand (1,000) feet ahead~~ shall display lighted head
3 and other lamps and illuminating devices as respectively
4 required for different classes of vehicles, subject to
5 exceptions with respect to parked vehicles. Stop lights,
6 turn signals and other signaling devices shall be lighted
7 as prescribed for those devices.

9 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2008.
