A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to liquor licenses; increasing the number
2 of bar and grill liquor licenses as specified; and
3 providing for an effective date.

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5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

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7 **Section 1.** W.S. 12-4-413(b)(iv) and by creating a new
8 paragraph (v) is amended to read:

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10 **12-4-413. Bar and grill liquor license; authorized;**
11 **requirements.**

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13 (b) The number of bar and grill liquor licenses for
14 cities and towns shall be based on the following population
15 formula:

1 (iv) Not more than one (1) additional license
2 for each additional twelve thousand five hundred (12,500)
3 population in incorporated cities over twenty-seven
4 thousand five hundred (27,500); and

6 (v) Not more than four (4) additional licenses
7 for incorporated cities for use in an area designated as a
8 downtown development district as provided in W.S. 15-9-201
9 through 15-9-223 for purposes of encouraging economic
10 development and downtown revitalization.

12 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2008.
