

## HOUSE BILL NO. HB0168

Bed and breakfast establishments.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to public health and safety; exempting  
2 license requirements and fees for bed and breakfast  
3 establishments; and providing for an effective date.

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5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

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7 **Section 1.** W.S. 35-7-124(b) is amended to read:

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9 **35-7-124. License required; exemptions; electronic**  
10 **transmittals.**

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12 (b) Written application for a new license shall be  
13 made on a form approved by the department of agriculture  
14 and provided by the department of agriculture or the local  
15 health department and shall be signed by the applicant. An  
16 initial license fee of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) shall  
17 accompany each application. The license fee for a temporary

1 food event shall be twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) which  
2 event shall not exceed fourteen (14) days. License  
3 requirements and fees for bed and breakfast establishments  
4 shall be waived. License requirements and fees for  
5 temporary food events operated by nonprofit organizations  
6 shall be waived. Licenses shall expire one (1) year after  
7 the date of issuance unless suspended or revoked. Licenses  
8 may be renewed each year upon application to the department  
9 or local health department accompanied by a fee of fifty  
10 dollars (\$50.00). Any establishment which has a license on  
11 the effective date of this section shall pay a fee of fifty  
12 dollars (\$50.00) for the following year and shall not be  
13 liable to pay the initial license fee of one hundred  
14 dollars (\$100.00).

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16 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2008.
