Prohibition on transfer taxes.

A BILL

for

1 A JOINT RESOLUTION proposing to amend the Wyoming
2 Constitution by prohibiting any tax upon the transfer of
3 title to or an interest in real property.

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5 *BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WYOMING,*
6 *two-thirds of all the members of the two houses, voting*
7 *separately, concurring therein:*

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9 **Section 1.** The following proposal to amend Wyoming
10 Constitution, Article 15, Section 13 is proposed for
11 submission to the electors of the State of Wyoming at the
12 next general election for approval or rejection to become
13 valid as a part of the Constitution if ratified by a
14 majority of the electors at the election:

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1 Article 15, Section 13. Tax must be authorized by
2 law; law to state object.

4 No tax shall be levied, except in pursuance of law, and
5 every law imposing a tax shall state distinctly the object
6 of the same, to which only it shall be applied. No tax
7 shall be levied upon the transfer of title to or an
8 interest in real property.

10 **Section 2.** That the Secretary of State shall endorse
11 the following statement on the proposed amendment:

13 The adoption of this amendment would prohibit the
14 state of Wyoming and local governments from imposing taxes
15 on the sale or transfer of title to or an interest in real
16 property.
