- 9 and 23-1-502(a) and by creating a new subsection (d) are

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- 12 9-2-1002. Definitions; powers generally; duties of
- 13 governor; provisions construed; cooperation with
- 14 legislature and judiciary; divisions enumerated.

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16 (a) As used in this act:

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- 2 (iii) "Entity" means any governmental unit,
- 3 special district, corporation, partnership or person which
- 4 will receive a legislative appropriation, directly or
- 5 indirectly, excluding the legislature, the judiciary and
- 6 the Wyoming department of transportation, game and fish
- 7 department except as provided in W.S. 23-1-502(d),
- 8 counties, municipalities and school districts;

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- 10 9-2-1010. Duties of budget division; biennial budgets
- 11 and appropriations.

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13 (a) The department through the budget division shall:

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- 15 (iii) Consult with each entity which will
- 16 require a legislative appropriation either directly or

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4 Except as provided in subsection (d) of this (a) 5 section, the commission shall govern its financial policies, subject to the written approval of its budgets by 6 7 The commission shall fix the budgets for the the governor. operation and maintenance of the department and 8 divisions for each fiscal year at its first stated meeting 9 of each fiscal year, and shall submit its budget estimates 10 11 for the following fiscal year as provided by W.S. 9-2-1012.

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requesting general funds to implement and maintain its sensitive species and nongame programs and shall submit that budget for review, recommendation and approval as provided in W.S. 9-2-1010 through 9-2-1014.1. Any funds appropriated by the legislature which are specified for these programs shall be retained in a separate account, expended only for such management and notwithstanding any other provision of law shall not be transferred or expended for any other purpose. In managing for sensitive species and nongame programs the commission shall not be limited to amounts appropriated by the legislature pursuant to this

subsection. The commission shall prepare a separate

accounting of the expenses incurred in each fiscal year for

the operation and maintenance of programs funded through

legislative appropriation and shall include the accounting

in its annual report.

Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2008.
