8	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

10	Section 1. W.S. 9-3-404 by creating a new subsection
11	(e), 9-3-443(a) and 35-9-610 are amended to read:

13	9-3-404. Wyoming retirement board; responsibility for
14	administration of system; composition; appointment; term;
15	vacancies; meetings; election of chairman; liability
16	limited.

1	(e) Pursuant to W.S. 9-3-443(a) and as provided by
2	the Wyoming Governmental Claims Act, individual board
3	members shall be granted immunity from liability while
4	acting within the scope of administering and operating the
5	retirement system and shall not be personally liable for
6	breaches of fiduciary duties in carrying out system
7	administration and operation except in cases of willful
8	misconduct or gross negligence.

10	9-3-443. Liability of trustee or other fiduciary.
11	
12	(a) A trustee or other fiduciary who by willful
13	misconduct or gross negligence breaches a duty imposed by
14	this act is personally liable to a retirement system for
15	any losses resulting from the breach and any profits made
16	by the trustee or other fiduciary through use of assets of
17	the system by the trustee or other fiduciary. The trustee
18	or other fiduciary is subject to other equitable remedies
19	as the court considers appropriate, including removal.

21	35-9-610. Board; established; nomination;
22	appointment; terms and qualification of members; liability
23	limited.

1 (a) There is established a volunteer firemen's 2 pension board to administer the volunteer firemen's pension 3 account. The board shall consist of six (6) members who 4 shall be appointed by the governor for staggered terms of 5 three (3) years. Appointments shall be made from nominees recommended to the governor by the Wyoming state firemen's 6 7 association. The nominees shall be volunteer firemen who have a minimum of five (5) years service as members of 8 9 volunteer fire departments in the state of Wyoming. The 10 governor may remove any board member as provided in W.S. 11 9-1-202.

13 (b) Pursuant to W.S. 9-3-443(a) and as provided by 14 the Wyoming Governmental Claims Act, individual board 15 members shall be granted immunity from liability while 16 acting within the scope of administering the pension 17 account and shall not be personally liable for breaches of 18 fiduciary duties in carrying out account administration 19 except in cases of willful misconduct or gross negligence.

Section 2. The intent of this act is to clarify the personal liability of public employee retirement system trustees and fiduciaries, including members of the Wyoming retirement board and the Wyoming volunteer fireman's

1	pension board, in the administration and operation of
2	respective retirement programs only. Nothing in this act
3	shall otherwise change or modify the intent and purpose of
4	the Uniform Management of Public Employees Retirement
5	Systems Act as provided in W.S. 9-3-433 through 9-3-452.
