A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to liquor licenses; expanding products
2 which may be sold in dispensing rooms; and providing for an
3 effective date.

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5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

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7 **Section 1.** W.S. 12-5-201(a) is amended to read:

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9 **12-5-201. Location, regulation and restrictions as to**
10 **place of sale; inspections; additional dispensing rooms.**

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12 (a) Except as otherwise provided in this section, the
13 principal place in which alcoholic liquor and malt
14 beverages are sold under a license shall be located in one
15 (1) room upon the premises for which the license is issued
16 and as approved by the licensing authority. Upon payment

1 of an additional license fee equal to two-thirds (2/3) of
2 the fee paid for the original license, a licensee may have
3 and maintain one (1) additional dispensing room in the same
4 building under the authority of the original license.
5 Alcoholic beverages secured in the licensed room by a
6 server may be served only in the building in which the
7 licensed room is located and in an immediately adjacent
8 fenced or enclosed area as approved by the local licensing
9 authority. This area shall not be in another building and
10 shall be located on the licensed premises. Only alcoholic
11 and malt beverages, nonalcoholic beverages, food, tobacco,
12 ~~and~~ alcoholic liquor and malt beverage promotional sales
13 items sold to the licensee bearing the name and trademark
14 of the alcoholic liquor and malt beverage firm or company
15 whose product the item is advertising, promotional products
16 bearing the name of the licensed retailer, billiard and
17 dart supplies, magazines and periodicals may be sold and
18 served in the licensed room. The licensing authority
19 shall, as often as necessary, inspect the licensed room and
20 adjoining rooms where alcoholic beverages are served to
21 insure that the licensee is in compliance with sanitation
22 and fire hazard requirements and other applicable laws. A
23 licensee may separate the facility for the sale of
24 alcoholic liquor and malt beverages for off-premise

1 consumption from the facility used to serve customers for
2 on-premise consumption without payment of an additional
3 fee. A separated facility for making sales for off-premise
4 consumption shall be located adjoining the facility for
5 making sales for on-premise consumption. The two (2)
6 facilities may be separated by a glass or other suitable
7 partition.

9 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2008.
