1 AN ACT relating to the Mental Health Professions Practice Act; modifying certification and provisional licensing 2 3 requirements; clarifying licensure and certification 4 reciprocity; and providing for an effective date. 5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming: 6 7 8 **Section 1.** W.S. 33-38-106(b)(intro), (c)(intro), 9 (d)(i), by creating a new paragraph (iii), by renumbering (iii) as (iv), by amending and renumbering (iv) as (v), by 10 11 renumbering (v) as (vi) and (n)(intro) and 33-38-108 are 12 amended to read: 13 33-38-106. Requirements for 14 licensure and certification. 15 16

1	(b) Certification under this subsection shall allow
2	practice as a certified social worker only under the
3	supervision of a qualified clinical supervisor and subject
4	to any other restrictions which may be specified by the
5	board. The board shall grant certification as a certified
6	social worker to any applicant who files an application
7	upon a form and in the manner prescribed by the board,
8	accompanied by the appropriate fee and who furnishes
9	satisfactory evidence to the board of the following:
10	
11	(c) <u>Certification under this subsection shall allow</u>
12	practice as a certified addictions practitioner only under
13	the supervision of a qualified clinical supervisor and
14	subject to any other restrictions which may be specified by
15	the board. The board shall grant certification as a
16	certified addictions practitioner to any applicant who
17	files an application upon a form and in the manner
18	prescribed by the board, accompanied by the appropriate fee
19	and who furnishes satisfactory evidence to the board of the
20	following:

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(d) Provisional licensure is a means to continue progress towards satisfactory completion of all licensure requirements under this act. Upon review and approval by

1	the designated board member or board, the board shall issue
2	a provisional license to any applicant who files an
3	application upon a form and in the manner prescribed by the
4	board, accompanied by the appropriate fee and who furnishes
5	satisfactory evidence to the board of the following:
6	
7	(i) The applicant has satisfied all requirements
8	for licensure other than the requirements for examination
9	and completion of the required hours of supervised clinical
10	experience reached the age of majority;
11	
12	(iii) The applicant meets one (1) of the
13	following educational requirements:
14	
15	(A) Holds a master's or doctorate degree in
16	one (1) of the disciplines identified from an accredited
16 17	one (1) of the disciplines identified from an accredited program and institution of higher education which is

6 (C) Holds a license for independent clinical practice in good standing in the identified 7 discipline for another licensing jurisdiction which does 8 9 not meet the criteria for reciprocal licensure under this 10 act. During the term of provisional licensure under this 11 subsection, the applicant shall complete any program 12 deficiencies required to meet the academic and training 13 content standards established by the board.

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15 (iii)(iv) The provisional licensed professional 16 counselor, clinical social worker, marriage and family 17 therapist and addictions therapist shall be allowed to 18 practice only under the supervision of a qualified clinical 19 supervisor and in accordance with any other restrictions 20 specified by the board;

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22 (iv)(v) Unless extended, the provisional license 23 shall expire thirty-six (36) months after issuance or upon 24 receipt by the board of the applicant's passing examination

results, and completion of the required hours of 1 2 supervision issuance of a license by the board under this 3 act, whichever occurs first; 4 5 (v) (vi) The board may, for good cause shown, grant an extension of a provisional license subject to any 6 7 additional restrictions specified by the board. 8 9 Certification under this subsection shall allow (n) practice as a certified addictions practitioner assistant 10 11 only under the supervision of a qualified clinical 12 supervisor and subject to any other restrictions which may 13 be specified by the board. Unless extended, an applicant 14 has six (6) months from the date of employment to become certified. The board may for good cause grant an extension 15 of this period. The board shall grant certification as a 16 17 certified addictions practitioner assistant to any applicant who files an application upon a form and in the 18 19 manner prescribed by the board, accompanied by the 20 appropriate fee and who furnishes satisfactory evidence to 21 the board of the following: 22

23 **33-38-108.** Reciprocity.

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1	(a) The board may issue a license or certification by
2	endorsement <u>Any</u> individual holding a license in good
3	standing to engage in the practice of professional
4	counseling, clinical social work, social work, marriage and
5	family therapy and <u>or</u> addictions therapy and treatment to
6	any applicant who has a license or certificate in good
7	standing with no formal complaints or sanctions as a
8	professional counselor, a marriage and family therapist, a
9	clinical social worker, under the laws of another state
10	having licensure requirements substantially similar to
11	those required by this act may, upon approval of the board,
12	be issued a license to practice in this state.

(b) Any individual holding a certification in good 14 standing to engage in the practice of social worker, mental 15 health worker, addictions practitioner work 16 or an addictions therapist therapy under the laws of another 17 18 jurisdiction if the applicant presents proof satisfactory 19 to the board that, at the time of application for a Wyoming 20 license or state having certification by endorsement, the applicant possesses credentials and qualifications 21 22 requirements substantially comparable similar to those required by this act as determined by may, upon approval of 23

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1	the board, be issued certification to practice in this
2	state.
3	
4	(c) The board shall promulgate rules and regulations
5	setting forth the manner in which credentials will shall be
6	reviewed by the board.
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8	Section 2. W.S. 33-38-106(b)(iv), (c)(iv) and (n)(iv)
9	is repealed.
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11	Section 3. This act is effective July 1, 2008.
