Board of parole-authorizing changes in length of parole.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to parole; authorizing the granting of
2 "good time" for parolees as specified; authorizing
3 sanctions for violating conditions of parole; and providing
4 for an effective date.

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6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

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8 **Section 1.** W.S. 7-13-408 by creating a new subsection
9 (e) and 7-13-420(a) are amended to read:

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11 **7-13-408. Probation, parole and conditional release**
12 **revocation hearing procedures.**

14 (e) The department may establish by rule and
15 regulation a system of imposing the administrative
16 sanctions specified in W.S. 7-13-1107(b) as an alternative
17 to revocation of the parole of any parolee who has violated

1 a condition of his parole. Parolees committed to the
2 county jail or a residential community correctional program
3 pursuant to this subsection shall be housed in accordance
4 with W.S. 7-13-1107(c) or 7-18-115(b).

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6 **7-13-420. Good time allowances.**

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8 (a) The governor, after consultation with the board
9 and the department, shall adopt rules and regulations to
10 establish a system of good time and special good time
11 allowances for inmates of and parolees from any state penal
12 institution, any institution which houses Wyoming inmates
13 pursuant to W.S. 7-3-401 or any correctional facility
14 operated pursuant to a contract with the state under W.S.
15 7-22-102 or inmates or parolees transferred to a community
16 correctional facility pursuant to W.S. 7-18-109 or
17 7-18-115. The rules may provide either for good time to be
18 deducted from the maximum sentence or for good time to be
19 deducted from the minimum sentence imposed by the
20 sentencing court, or both, and may provide for the removal
21 of previously earned good time allowances and the
22 withholding of future good time allowances.
