1 AN ACT relating to health care services; providing a grant 2 program for physician recruitment; providing grant 3 eligibility and payment conditions; granting rulemaking authority; repealing a local matching funds requirement for 4 5 the physician and dentist loan repayment program; providing appropriations; authorizing a position; and providing for 6 7 an effective date. 9 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

Practitioners relocating to the 6 state of Wyoming to become employed by the state or by the 7 United States shall not be eligible for grants. 8 This 9 paragraph shall not apply to physicians taking a family 10 practice residency in the state or physicians employed by 11 the United States department of defense; 12 13 (iii) The recruitment conditions between 14 hospital and the physician shall meet the conditions set forth in 42 C.F.R. 411.357(e), as amended September 5, 15 16 2007; 17 18 (iv) Recruitment of new physicians shall 19 based on demonstrable need. Those recruiting persons or 20 entities demonstrating the greatest need, in the discretion 21 of the department shall be given the highest priority in 22 receiving grants pursuant to this section;

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1 (v) All recruitment incentives shall be in 2 writing and shall be reported on federal income tax forms; 3 4 (vi) The recruited physician shall agree to 5 provide medical services in the community to which he was recruited for a period of not less than two (2) years or he 6 7 shall repay any monies granted under this section to the state of Wyoming plus interest at the rate of ten percent 8 9 (10%) per annum; 10 11 The recruited physician shall agree to (vii) provide medical care for not less than two (2) years in 12 13 underserved areas of the state and shall accept patients 14 qualified under the Medical Assistance and Services Act, Title XVIII of the federal Social Security Act and the 15 child health insurance program who seek medical care which 16 17 the health care provider is qualified to provide or he shall repay any monies granted under this section to the 18 19 state of Wyoming plus interest at the rate of ten percent

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(10%) per annum;

22 (viii) Costs reimbursed through grants under the 23 program may include:

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1 (A) As incentive to the physician 2 recruitment process, recruitment actual costs, up to ten 3 thousand dollars (\$10,000.00) per recruited physician, may 4 be reimbursed to the successful recruiting person or entity 5 paying those costs; 6 7 (B) Relocation expenses, not to exceed twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000.00); 8 9 10 (C) Malpractice insurance premium for two 11 (2) years, not to exceed ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00) 12 per year; 13 14 Signing bonuses not to exceed thirty (D) thousand dollars (\$30,000.00). 15 16 17 (ix) Agreements between the department physicians pursuant to W.S. 9-2-118 may be coordinated with 18 19 grants and incorporated into grant agreements pursuant to 20 this section; and 21 22 (x) The department in administering the program shall attempt to issue at least one-half (1/2) of all 23

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2 There is appropriated ninety thousand dollars (b) 3 (\$90,000.00) from the general fund and one (1) half-time 4 position is authorized to the department of health. This 5 appropriation shall be for the period beginning with the effective date of this act and ending June 30, 2010. This 6 appropriation shall only be expended for the purpose of 7 administering the physician recruitment program created by 8 9 W.S. 35-1-1101. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, 10 this appropriation shall not be transferred or expended for 11 any other purpose and any unexpended, unobligated funds remaining from this appropriation shall revert as provided 12 13 by law on July 1, 2010. This appropriation shall be 14 included in the department's 2011-2012 standard biennial 15 budget request.

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Section 5. This act is effective immediately upon completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming Constitution.
