A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to Hathaway scholarship program; modifying
2 success curriculum foreign language requirements; and
3 providing for an effective date.

5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

6

7 **Section 1.** W.S. 21-16-1307(b)(v), (c)(iii)(D), (d)(v)
8 and (e)(ii) is amended to read:

9

10 **21-16-1307. Success curriculum; test standards.**

11

12 (b) The success curriculum required to qualify for
13 honor or performance scholarship eligibility under this
14 article for students graduating from high school in the
15 2010-2011 school year shall be as follows:

16

1 (v) Foreign language - two (2) sequenced years
2 of the same foreign language which need not be taken
3 consecutively, at least one (1) of which shall be taken in
4 grades nine (9) through twelve (12). Two (2) sequenced
5 years of instruction in the native language of the Eastern
6 Shoshone or the Northern Arapaho, or two (2) sequenced
7 years of certified instruction in American sign language,
8 either of which need not be taken consecutively, but at
9 least one (1) year of which is taken in grades nine (9)
10 through twelve (12), may be taken in fulfillment of this
11 paragraph.

13 (c) The success curriculum required to qualify for
14 honor or performance scholarship eligibility under this
15 article for students graduating from high school prior to
16 the 2010-2011 school year shall be as follows:

18 (iii) For students graduating in the 2009-2010
19 school year:

21 (D) Foreign language - one (1) year of
22 foreign language which may include one (1) year of
23 instruction in the native language of the Eastern Shoshone
24 or the Northern Arapaho or one (1) year of certified

1 instruction in American sign language, taken in grades nine
2 (9) through (12).

4 (d) The success curriculum required to qualify for
5 opportunity scholarship eligibility under this article for
6 students graduating from high school in the 2010-2011
7 school year shall be as follows:

8

9 (v) Foreign language - demonstrate proficiency
10 on the state standards for the foreign cultures and
11 languages common core of knowledge requirement under W.S.
12 21-9-101(b) (i) (K) which may include American sign language
13 as one (1) component of foreign language proficiency.

14

15 (e) The success curriculum required to qualify for
16 career scholarship eligibility under this article for
17 students graduating from high school in the 2010-2011
18 school year shall be the curriculum required for high
19 school graduation under W.S. 21-2-304(a)(iii) subject to
20 the following:

22 (ii) Demonstration of proficiency on the state
23 standards for the foreign cultures and languages common
24 core of knowledge requirement under W.S. 21-9-101(b) (i) (K)

1 which may include American sign language as one (1)
2 component of foreign language proficiency.

3

4 **Section 2.** This act is effective immediately upon
5 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
6 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
7 Constitution.
