Community colleges-capital construction-2.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to community colleges; providing
2 appropriations for certain capital construction projects as
3 specified; providing for carry over of unexpended funds;
4 and providing for an effective date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7

8 **Section 1.**

9

10 (a) There is appropriated from the general fund to
11 the Wyoming community college commission the following
12 amounts for expenditure for the capital construction
13 projects listed:

14

15 (i) Ten million dollars (\$10,000,000.00) for the
16 center for training and development at Casper College;

17

1 (ii) Eleven million four hundred thirty-four
2 thousand dollars (\$11,434,000.00) for the applied science
3 and technology classroom building at Northwest Wyoming
4 Community College;

5
6 (iii) Nine million nine hundred seventeen
7 thousand dollars (\$9,917,000.00) for the applied health and
8 trades project building at Central Wyoming Community
9 College.

10
11 (b) The funds appropriated under subsection (a) of
12 this section shall be retained by the commission and made
13 available to the community college to fund the authorized
14 project only to the extent that funds have first been
15 received by the community college from other nongeneral
16 fund sources, public or private, in the following amounts:

17
18 (i) Ten million two hundred fifty thousand
19 dollars (\$10,250,000.00) match for the project authorized
20 under paragraph (a)(i) of this section;

22 (ii) Four million three hundred twenty-nine
23 thousand dollars (\$4,329,000.00) match for the project
24 authorized under paragraph (a)(ii) of this section;

2 (iii) Nine million nine hundred seventeen
3 thousand dollars (\$9,917,000.00) match for the project
4 authorized under paragraph (a)(iii) of this section.

5

6 **Section 2.** Notwithstanding W.S. 9-2-1008, 9-2-1012(e)
7 and 9-4-207, any funds appropriated under Section 1 of this
8 act which are unexpended as of June 30, 2010, shall not
9 revert but shall be retained by the community college
10 commission for the purposes specified in Section 1 of this
11 act and shall remain until the project is completed.

13 **Section 3.** This act is effective July 1, 2008.
