## A BILL

## for

1 AN ACT relating to state parks and cultural resources; 2 providing for an increase in size of old south pass city 3 historical reserve; providing for acceptance of a land transfer; providing an appropriation; providing for a 4 5 report; and providing for an effective date. 6 7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming: 8 9 **Section 1.** W.S. 36-8-501(b) is amended to read: 10 36-8-501. Powers generally. 11 12

1 (b) Upon approval by the governor, the department of 2 state parks and cultural resources may purchase in the name of the state of Wyoming the following real property, unless 3 4 the Carissa gold mine has created unacceptable economical 5 environmental impacts as shown by the department of 6 environmental quality investigation and determined by the 7 governor, in Fremont county containing approximately 216.46 312.41 acres which are hereby declared to be part of the 8 9 Old South Pass Historical Preserve-Wyoming:

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(i) In township 29 north, range 100 west, 6th p.m., SE1/4 SE1/4 NE1/4, NE1/4 NE1/4 SE1/4 of section 20; lots 6, 7, 9, 16, 19 and 24 of section 20; W1/2 SW1/4 NW1/4 of section 21; E1/2 SW1/4 NW1/4 of section 21; and W1/4 SE1/4 NW1/4 of section 21.

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19 (a) There is appropriated three hundred thirty-six 20 thousand dollars (\$336,000.00) from the general fund to the 21 department of state parks and cultural resources. This 22 appropriation shall be for the period beginning with the 23 effective date of this act and ending June 30, 2011. This

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appropriation shall only be expended for the purpose of 1 2 construction of a trial and abandoned mine mitigation at south pass city to comply with the requirements of a land 3 patent transfer from the bureau of land management pursuant 4 5 to the federal recreational and public purposes act. 6 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, this 7 appropriation shall not be transferred or expended for any other purpose and any unexpended, unobligated 8 funds 9 remaining from this appropriation shall revert as provided 10 by law on June 30, 2011. This appropriation shall not be 11 included in the department's 2011-2012 standard biennial 12 budget request.

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14 (b) The legislature accepts the transfer of lands located at township 29 north, range 100 west, 6<sup>th</sup> p.m., lots 15 6, 7, 9, 16, 19 and 24 of section 20 from the bureau of 16 land management to the department of state parks and 17 18 cultural resources upon the completion of all acts 19 necessary to comply with the requirements of a land patent 20 transfer from the bureau of land management pursuant to the federal recreational and public purposes act. 21

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(c) On or before October 1, 2011, the department of 1 state parks and cultural resources shall report to the 2 3 joint travel, recreation, wildlife and cultural resources interim committee on the status of the construction 4 authorized under subsection (a) of this section and the 5 status of the land patent transfer authorized under 6 7 subsection (b) of this section. 8 9 Section 3. This act is effective July 1, 2009. 10
