- 8 **Section 1.** W.S. 9-2-2303(a) by creating a new
- 9 paragraph (iv), 9-2-2306(a)(vi), by creating a new
- 10 paragraph (vii) and 9-2-2307(a) are amended to read:

12 **9-2-2303. Definitions.**

1	(a) As used in this article:
2	
3	(iv) "Cultural and heritage area" means a
4	developed area of public and private uses that:
5	
6	(A) Ranges in size from a portion of a
7	county or municipality to a regional area with a special
8	coherence;
9	
10	(B) Is distinguished by physical and
11	cultural resources which have played a vital role in the
12	historic life and development of the region and contribute
13	to the public through interpretive, educational and
14	recreational uses; and
15	
16	(c) Is composed of contiguous or
17	noncontiguous areas.
18	
19	9-2-2306. Wyoming cultural trust fund board; duties
20	and responsibilities.
21	
22	(a) The board shall:
23	

1	(vi) Consider other necessary matters; and.
2	
3	(vii) Establish subreview or advisory councils
4	as appropriate to grant categories.
5	
6	(d) The board may recognize a Wyoming cultural and
7	heritage area or corridor and provide grant funds in a
8	phased process to facilitate designation, development and
9	promotion of cultural and heritage areas.
10	
11	9-2-2307. Disbursement of grants from trust fund
12	investment earnings.
13	
14	(a) Subject to approval of applications from
15	nonprofit and governmental cultural, historical and arts
16	organizations, the board may award grants to:
17	
18	(i) Promote, preserve and enhance the unique
19	cultural heritage of Wyoming and its people; or
20	
21	(ii) Facilitate designation, development and
22	promotion of cultural and heritage areas.
23	

1	Section 2. There is appropriated one million four
2	hundred thirty thousand dollars (\$1,430,000.00) from the
3	general fund to the Wyoming cultural trust fund created by
4	W.S. 9-2-2304. This appropriation shall be for the period
5	beginning with the effective date of this act and ending
6	June 30, 2010. This appropriation shall only be expended
7	for the purpose of funding cultural and heritage area
8	grants under the trust fund. Notwithstanding 9-2-1008, 9-
9	2-1012(e) and $9-4-207$, these funds which are unexpended,
10	unobligated or unencumbered as of June 30, 2010 shall not
11	revert to the general fund but shall be retained by the
12	department for the purposes specified in this section.
13	This appropriation shall not be included in the cultural
14	trust fund commission's 2011-2012 standard biennial budget
15	request.
16	

17 Section 3. This act is effective July 1, 2009.
