A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to the Wyoming arts council; modifying the 2 council's name; clarifying the relationship between the 3 arts council board and the department of state parks and 4 cultural resources; providing for duties of the board; 5 providing for duties of the department; providing 6 definitions; and providing for an effective date.

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8 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

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10 Section 1. W.S. 9-2-901(a) and by creating a new 11 subsection (c), 9-2-902(a), 9-2-903(a)(intro) and (iii) and 12 by creating a new subsection (c), 9-2-904(a)(intro), (i) 13 and by creating a new paragraph (iv), (c) and by creating

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1 new subsections (d) and (e), 9-2-905(a)(i) through (iv), 9-2 2-906, 9-2-907(a) and by creating a new subsection (c), 9-3 2-908(a), (b), (c) and (e), 9-2-910(b) and 9-2-2035(a)(ii)(B) are amended to read: 4 5 6 9-2-901. Creation; membership; appointment; removal; 7 qualifications; recommendations thereto; definitions. 8 9 (a) The Wyoming council on the arts council board is 10 created as an advisory council board within the department 11 of state parks and cultural resources, consisting of ten 12 (10) members appointed by the governor who are removable by 13 the governor as provided in W.S. 9-1-202. The members 14 shall be residents of Wyoming who are known for their competence and experience in all fields of the performing 15 16 and fine arts. 17 18 (c) As used in this article: 19 20 (i) "Board" means the Wyoming arts council board created in subsection (a) of this section; 21 22

1 (ii) "Department" means the department of state 2 parks and cultural resources. 3 4 9-2-902. Terms of members; vacancies; chairman and 5 vice-chairman; expenses; personnel. 6 7 (a) The term of office of each member of the council board is three (3) years. Vacancies shall be filled by the 8 9 governor for the unexpired term. The council board shall select from its membership a chairman and vice-chairman. 10 11 The members of the council board shall receive no compensation, but shall be reimbursed under W.S. 9-3-102 12 13 and 9-3-103 for travel and per diem expenses incurred in 14 the performance of their duties. 15 9-2-903. Duties of department; duties of board. 16 17 18 (a) The department, of state parks and cultural 19 resources, in consultation with the council board, shall: 20 21 (iii) <u>Make recommendations concerning Develop</u> 22 appropriate methods and programs to encourage participation

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in and appreciation of the arts to meet the legitimate 1 2 needs and aspirations of persons in all parts of the state; 3 (C) The board may: 4 5 6 (i) Work with the department to encourage and 7 facilitate public interest in the cultural heritage of the 8 state and to expand the state's cultural resources; 9 (ii) Advise the department on program planning, 10 11 policy formulation and fiscal responsibilities; 12 13 (iii) Participate in the development and review 14 of long and short range plans for the arts in Wyoming and 15 advise the department in developing policies to implement 16 those plans; 17 18 (iv) Make recommendations to the governor for appointments to fill board vacancies and for appointments 19 to the cultural trust fund board as provided in W.S. 9-2-20 21 2305(A)(ii)(B);

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1	(v) Make recommendations to the director of the
2	department and administrator of the division of cultural
3	resources within the department on the selection of the
4	manager of the Wyoming arts council program;
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6	(vi) Appoint committees and task forces to carry
7	out any duties deemed necessary by the board;
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9	(vii) Chair grant review committees or panels
10	and approve the membership of grant review panels,
11	committees and artist rosters;
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13	(viii) Consider recommendations of grant review
14	committees and panels and approve grants to artists, arts
15	organizations and other applicants;
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17	(ix) Review and recommend to the department a
18	budget for arts programs and advise the department on the
19	allocation of state and federal funds;
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21	(x) Review and recommend arts programs, approve
22	guidelines for programs and oversee the arts grant making
23	functions of the department;

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2	(xi) Actively promote and advocate for the arts
3	throughout the state and the region.
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5	9-2-904. Powers; receipt of assistance and data;
6	receipt of money and property.
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8	(a) The <u>council board</u> may:
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10	(i) Hold public and private hearings;
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12	(iv) Appoint such advisory committees as it
13	deems necessary to carry out its duties.
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15	(c) The department may receive any money or property
16	of any kind or character, donated, granted or bequeathed to
17	the council board, the department or to the state of
18	Wyoming for the purposes of furthering the objectives of
19	the department's programs arts program. Money received and
20	the proceeds of other property received under this
21	subsection shall be deposited in a separate revenue account
22	to be expended upon legislative approval for purposes of
23	this article.

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2	(d) The department may:
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4	(i) Hold public hearings;

7	grants furthering the objectives of the department's arts

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18	Subarticle A
19	Endowments
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21	9-2-905. Definitions.
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23	(a) As used in this article:

1 2 (i) "Approved request" means the amount approved by the department in consultation with the Wyoming arts 3 4 council board from the state account for distribution to a 5 qualifying organization; 6 7 (ii) <u>"Council"</u> "Board" means the Wyoming arts council advisory board; 8 9 (iii) "Endowment fund" means any arts endowment 10 11 fund created under this article subarticle by a qualifying 12 organization; 13 14 (iv) "Qualifying organization" means any Wyoming 15 nonprofit arts, cultural or historical organization that qualifies under this article subarticle to create an 16 17 endowment fund, receive state monies into the endowment 18 fund, match state monies deposited into the endowment fund and expend interest earned on the endowment fund; 19 20 9-2-906. Wyoming arts endowment account. 21 22

The Wyoming arts endowment account is created. The account 1 2 shall be administered by the council department in accordance with applicable law. The account shall contain 3 all monies appropriated to it by the legislature. 4 The 5 purpose of the account is to provide for the cultural 6 enrichment and benefit of citizens throughout the state of 7 Wyoming by providing monies to qualifying arts or cultural organizations to enable them to create their own arts 8 9 endowment funds and to provide for administrative expenses of the council department in implementing W.S. 9-2-905 10 11 through 9-2-911.

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9-2-907. Arts organization endowment fund.

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15 (a) Any Wyoming nonprofit arts, cultural or 16 historical organization may create an endowment fund into which there may be deposited monies from the state account. 17 18 The principal of each endowment fund may not be expended by 19 the qualifying organization. and shall be held in perpetuity solely by the qualifying organization or by the council on 20 21 behalf of the qualifying organization. Only interest 22 income earned on the amount in each endowment fund may be 23 expended by the qualifying organization.

1 (vi) In accordance with Wyoming Administrative 2 Procedure Act, establish criteria by rule not otherwise 3 prescribed in this article for determining the eligibility 4 of qualifying organizations to receive monies from the 5 state account. 6 7 9-2-908. Eligibility requirements of qualifying arts 8 9 organizations; allocation limitations; matching 10 requirements. 11 12 (a) Any qualifying organization may apply to receive monies from the state account to be deposited in the 13 14 qualifying organization's endowment fund: 15 (i) If it has received a grant from the council 16 17 department during one (1) of the three (3) years 18 immediately before making application for state fund monies under this subsection; or 19 20 21 (ii) Upon approval by the council department if it has not received a grant from the council department 22 23 within the past three (3) years;

1 (iii) If it has met eligibility requirements 2 established by the council department 3 under W.S. 9 2 903(b)(vi)9-2-907(c)(iv). 4 5 6 The council department in consultation with the (b) 7 board may allocate monies from the state account subject to 8 the following limitations: 9 (i) The maximum amount that may be allocated to 10 11 each qualifying organization from the state account shall 12 be determined by the council department in consultation 13 with the board by calculating the average cash income of 14 the qualifying organization during the past three (3) 15 fiscal years as contained in the qualifying organization's 16 financial reports on file with the council department. The council department shall notify each 17 qualifying 18 organization of the maximum amount of monies from the state account for which it qualifies; 19 20 (c) After the council department in consultation with 21 22 the board determines that a qualifying organization is 23 eligible to receive monies from the state account and

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1 before is allocated to the any money qualifying 2 organization from the state account, the qualifying 3 organization shall match the amount qualified for by monies raised and designated exclusively for that purpose. State 4 5 monies, in-kind contributions, and preexisting endowment gifts may not be used to match monies from the state 6 7 account. 8 9 Monies from the state account shall (e) be 10 distributed subject to the following requirements: 11 12 (i) Qualifying organizations shall raise a cash 13 amount equal to the approved request within three (3) years 14 after applying for monies from the state account by a date 15 determined by the council department. For purposes of 16 partial distribution of an approved amount, the council 17 department shall review the amount of matching funds 18 received by a qualifying organization on an annual basis; 19 20 (ii) Monies from the state account shall be 21 released to the qualifying organization only upon verification to the council department that the matching 22

23 monies have been received on or before the date determined

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1 under paragraph (i) of this subsection. Partial 2 distribution of an approved amount shall be made on an 3 annual basis in an amount equal to the matching monies 4 received by a qualifying organization upon verification to 5 the <u>council_department</u>;

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9-2-910. Spending restrictions; return of endowment.
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9 (b) If the council department determines that a 10 qualifying organization has expended any amount of the 11 endowment monies received from the state account or any 12 amount of the required matching monies, the qualifying 13 organization shall return the amount it received from the 14 state account. The council department in consultation with 15 the board shall reallocate any such returned monies to qualifying organizations in the manner as provided in W.S. 16 17 9-2-909.

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9-2-2305. Wyoming cultural trust fund board;
creation; members.

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(a) There is created the Wyoming cultural trust fund 1 2 board. The board shall consist of five (5) members, as 3 follows: 4 5 (ii) Four (4) persons appointed by the governor 6 and confirmed by the senate from the following nominees: 7 8 (B) Two (2) persons nominated by the 9 Wyoming arts council board. 10 11 Section 2. W.S. 9-2-903(b) and 9-2-904(a)(ii) and 12 (iii) are repealed. 13 Section 3. This act is effective July 1, 2009. 14 15 16 (END)
