AN ACT relating to cultural heritage tourism and state historic sites; providing appropriations for capital construction and interpretation; and providing for an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

Section 1.

There is appropriated six hundred fifty thousand (a) dollars (\$650,000.00) from the budget reserve account to department of state parks and cultural resources. the Notwithstanding W.S. 9-2-1008, 9-2-1012(e) and 9-4-207, these funds which are unexpended, unobligated or unencumbered as of June 30, 2010 shall not revert to the general fund but shall be retained by the department for specified in this subsection. the purposes This appropriation shall not be included in the department's standard biennial 2011-2012 budget request. This appropriation shall only be expended for the following purposes and notwithstanding any other provision of law, this appropriation shall not be transferred or expended for any other purpose:

(i) Three hundred thirty-one thousand dollars (\$331,000.00) for capital construction at Fort Fred Steele historic site for building restoration and stabilization, a facility host site and interpretive trails;

(ii) One hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000.00) for capital construction at the Piedmont charcoal kilns for stone restoration work, upgrading the path system and providing access for those with disabilities;

(iii) Two hundred nineteen thousand dollars (\$219,000.00) for improvements at the Carissa mine site.

(b) There is appropriated three hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$350,000.00) from the budget reserve account to the department of state parks and cultural Notwithstanding W.S. 9-2-1008, 9-2-1012(e) and resources. 9-4-207, these funds which are unexpended, unobligated or unencumbered as of June 30, 2010 shall not revert to the general fund but shall be retained by the department for purposes specified in this subsection. This the appropriation shall not be included in the department's 2011-2012 standard biennial request. budget This appropriation shall only be expended for improvements in interpretation at the department's historical and the archeological sites.
