A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to the legislature; recreating the select
2 committee on local government financing as specified;
3 providing for appointments; requiring a report; providing
4 an appropriation; and providing for an effective date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7

8 **Section 1.**

9

10 (a) There is created a select committee on local
11 government financing consisting of the following members:

12

13 (i) Five (5) members of the Wyoming senate
14 appointed by the president of the senate, comprised of one
15 (1) member at-large from among the senate membership and

1 one (1) member from each of the following senate
2 committees:

4 (A) Appropriations;

5

6 (B) Revenue;

7

8 (C) Corporations, elections and political
9 subdivisions;

10

11 (D) Minerals, business and economic
12 development.

14 (ii) Five (5) members of the Wyoming house of
15 representatives appointed by the speaker of the house,
16 comprised of one (1) member at-large from among the house
17 membership and one (1) member from each of the following
18 house committees:

20 (A) Appropriations;

22 (B) Revenue;

1 (C) Corporations, elections and political
2 subdivisions;

4 (D) Minerals, business and economic
5 development.

6

7 (b) The select committee shall select a chairman from
8 among its members. The committee shall investigate,
9 develop and recommend a workable statutory formula for the
10 distribution of revenues to counties and a workable
11 statutory formula for the distribution of revenues to
12 cities. The committee's recommendations shall be submitted
13 to the governor and the joint appropriations interim
14 committee prior to November 1, 2009. The joint
15 appropriations interim committee shall consider the
16 recommendations in its preparation of the general
17 appropriations bill for the 2010 budget session and shall
18 sponsor legislation to implement the recommendations as it
19 deems appropriate.

20

21 **Section 2.** There is appropriated twenty thousand
22 dollars (\$20,000.00) from the general fund to the
23 legislative service office. This appropriation shall be
24 for the period beginning with the effective date of this

1 act and ending June 30, 2010. This appropriation shall
2 only be expended for the purpose of paying expenses
3 incurred by the select committee under this act.
4 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, this
5 appropriation shall not be transferred or expended for any
6 other purpose and any unexpended, unobligated funds
7 remaining from this appropriation shall revert as provided
8 by law on June 30, 2010.

9

10 **Section 3.** This act is effective immediately upon
11 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
12 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
13 Constitution.
