Game and fish-landowner coupon redemption period.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to game and fish; extending deadline for
2 submission of landowner coupons; and providing for an
3 effective date.

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5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

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7 **Section 1.** W.S. 23-3-105(b) is amended to read:

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9 **23-3-105. Antelope, deer and elk coupons; payment to**
10 **landowner; kill on federal or state land.**

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12 (b) The landowner's coupon shall promptly be
13 detached, dated, signed and delivered to the landowner.
14 The landowner on or before ~~February~~March 1 following the
15 year for which the license was valid, shall deliver to the
16 department the coupon and an affidavit that the antelope,

1 deer or elk for which the coupon was delivered was killed
2 on his land. Upon receipt of the coupon and affidavit the
3 department shall pay the landowner sixteen dollars (\$16.00)
4 for each coupon from an antelope, deer or elk license.
5 Landowner's coupons are not transferable. Any unauthorized
6 person attempting to collect any sum for any landowner's
7 coupon is guilty of a high misdemeanor punishable as
8 provided in W.S. 23-6-202(a)(ii). Effective January 1,
9 2000, the department shall provide a checkoff box on each
10 landowner coupon affidavit claim form that offers the
11 claimant the opportunity to designate the animal damage
12 management board to receive his payment amount for
13 landowner coupons claimed on that form. For each claim
14 made where the landowner has designated his payment to the
15 animal damage management board, the department shall
16 transfer that amount to the animal damage management
17 account created by W.S. 11-6-306 and the department shall
18 retain the fees related to those administrative costs of
19 the transfer.

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21 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2009.
