Youthful drivers restricted licenses.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to restricted licenses; allowing young
2 drivers to hold both class C and class M licenses; and
3 providing for an effective date.

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5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

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7 **Section 1.** W.S. 31-7-117(c)(intro) is amended to
8 read:

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10 **31-7-117. Restricted licenses.**

12 (c) The division may issue a restricted class "C" or
13 "M" license, or both such licenses, to a person who is
14 between the ages of fourteen (14) and sixteen (16) years
15 upon receipt of application, payment of the proper fees, an
16 affidavit of extreme inconvenience signed by the parent or

guardian having custody of the applicant and a finding by the highway patrol that extreme inconvenience actually exists. The applicant shall successfully pass the examination required by W.S. 31-7-114. The licensee may drive a vehicle only between the hours of 5:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m., within a fifty (50) mile radius of his domicile and only at the direction of his parent or guardian. If any person while licensed under this subsection, receives a citation for a moving violation, the division, upon receipt of the notice of conviction, shall suspend the license and any other license or permit evidencing that person's privilege to operate a motor vehicle. For purposes of this subsection "extreme inconvenience" includes the following circumstances:

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16 **Section 2.** This act is effective immediately upon
17 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
18 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
19 Constitution.
