A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to county officials; increasing county
2 official's salaries; increasing district attorneys'
3 salaries; and providing for an effective date.

5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

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7 **Section 1.** W.S. 9-1-802(d) and 18-3-107(a)(i) by
8 creating a new subparagraph (C) are amended to read:

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10 **9-1-802. Election; term; qualifications; full-time;**
11 **private practice prohibited; exception; salary; vacancies.**

13 (d) Until January 3, 2011, each district attorney
14 shall receive an annual salary of ninety-four thousand five
15 hundred dollars (\$94,500.00). From and after January 3,

1 2011, each district attorney shall receive an annual salary
2 of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000.00).

4 **18-3-107. Annual salaries of certain officers;**
5 **additional compensation prohibited; exception as to**
6 **traveling and other expenses; compensation of county**
7 **commissioner; appointment and salaries of deputies, clerks,**
8 **stenographers and other assistants.**

10 (a) County officers shall be paid as follows:

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12 (i) The county assessor, part-time county and
13 prosecuting attorneys, part-time county attorneys, county
14 clerk, clerk of district court, county sheriff and county
15 treasurer in their respective counties shall receive as
16 annual salaries:

18 (C) From and after January 3, 2011, not
19 less than ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00) nor more than
20 one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000.00).

22 **Section 2.** W.S. 18-3-107(a)(i)(A) and (ii)(A) is
23 repealed.
