Health care professions database.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to the Wyoming health care commission;
2 providing that the department of health shall maintain the
3 commission's health professions database; providing for
4 publication of a health professions statistical handbook;
5 providing appropriations; and providing for an effective
6 date.

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8 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

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10 **Section 1.** The department of health shall assume from
11 the Wyoming health care commission responsibility for
12 managing and maintaining the health professions database
13 developed by the commission. The department may continue
14 to use the memorandum of understanding it has developed
15 with the University of Wyoming for managing and maintaining
16 the database until the time it is appropriate to rebid this

1 function. The department shall publish an updated
2 statistical handbook based on the database from time to
3 time, but at least once per biennium.

5 **Section 2.**

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7 (a) There is appropriated two hundred fourteen
8 thousand dollars (\$214,000.00) from the general fund to the
9 department of health. This appropriation shall be for the
10 period beginning with the effective date of this act and
11 ending June 30, 2010. This appropriation shall only be
12 expended for the purpose of project management, data
13 collection and database management related to the health
14 professions database as provided in this act.
15 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, this
16 appropriation shall not be transferred or expended for any
17 other purpose and any unexpended, unobligated funds
18 remaining from this appropriation shall revert as provided
19 by law on June 30, 2010.

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21 (b) There is appropriated sixteen thousand dollars
22 (\$16,000.00) from the general fund to the department of
23 health. This appropriation shall be for the period
24 beginning with the effective date of this act and ending

1 June 30, 2010. This appropriation shall only be expended
2 for the purpose of printing the health professions
3 statistical handbook required by section 1 of this act.
4 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, this
5 appropriation shall not be transferred or expended for any
6 other purpose and any unexpended, unobligated funds
7 remaining from this appropriation shall revert as provided
8 by law on June 30, 2010.

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10 (c) There is appropriated one hundred forty thousand
11 dollars (\$140,000.00) from the general fund to the
12 department of health. This appropriation shall be for the
13 period beginning with the effective date of this act and
14 ending June 30, 2010. This appropriation shall only be
15 expended for the purpose of data analysis and reporting
16 required by section 1 of this act. Notwithstanding any
17 other provision of law, this appropriation shall not be
18 transferred or expended for any other purpose and any
19 unexpended, unobligated funds remaining from this
20 appropriation shall revert as provided by law on June 30,
21 2010. This appropriation shall not be included in the
22 department's 2011-2012 standard biennial budget request.

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
