School finance-distance education.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to school finance; excluding specified
2 district revenues from local resource computations used in
3 computing foundation program amounts; and providing for an
4 effective date.

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6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

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8 **Section 1.** W.S. 21-13-310(a)(ix) is amended to read:

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10 **21-13-310. Annual computation of district revenues.**

12 (a) To ensure revenues available to each district are
13 uniformly sufficient to enable compliance with the uniform
14 standards for educational programs prescribed under W.S.
15 21-9-101 and 21-9-102 and to secure state board
16 accreditation of educational programs under W.S.
17 21-2-304(a)(ii), the revenues specified under this

1 subsection shall be deemed state revenues and shall be
2 considered in determining the amount to be distributed to
3 each district under W.S. 21-13-311. A district shall make
4 an annual computation of the following revenues:

6 (ix) The amount of tuition paid to the district
7 during the previous school year, including any amount
8 charged under W.S. 21-4-501 and any amount assessed in
9 excess of the costs incurred for adult education programs,
10 summer school programs, programs provided under an
11 agreement for cooperative educational programs under W.S.
12 21-20-101 through 21-20-111 and any amount assessed for
13 programs and services for children with disabilities, but
14 excluding any tuition assessed by a district for the
15 provision of distance education programs to participating
16 nonresident students pursuant to W.S. 21-13-330;

18 **Section 2.** This act is effective immediately upon
19 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
20 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
21 Constitution.
