A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to the Wyoming Governmental Claims Act;
2 specifying where claims shall be filed and the contents
3 thereof; repealing an obsolete provision; and providing for
4 an effective date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 1-39-113(c) and by creating a new
9 subsection (d) is amended to read:

10

11 **1-39-113. Claims procedure.**

12

13 (c) All claims against the state shall be presented
14 to the general services division of the department of
15 administration and information. Claims against any other
16 governmental entity shall be filed at the business office

1 of that entity. In the case of claims against local
2 governments the claim submitted need not be acted upon by
3 the entity prior to suit. For purposes of this section,

4 "business office" means:

5
6 (i) The county clerk of a county, including its
7 agencies, instrumentalities and institutions;

8
9 (ii) The city or town clerk of a city or town,
10 including its agencies, instrumentalities and institutions;

11
12 (iii) The secretary of a joint powers board,
13 airport board, public corporation, community college
14 district board of trustees or special district;

15
16 (iv) The superintendent of a school district;

17
18 (v) The office of the president of the
19 University of Wyoming.

20
21 (d) In any appeal under this act, the claimant shall
22 state:

23

(i) That the claim required under subsection (c)
of this section was filed in accordance with this section;

(ii) The date the claim under subsection (c) of
this section was filed;

(iii) That the claim was in compliance with the signature and certification requirements of article 16, section 7 of the Wyoming Constitution.

Section 2. W.S. 1-39-121(b) is repealed.

Section 3. This act is effective July 1, 2010.
