A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to game and fish; providing for youth
2 archery licenses; setting fees for the licenses; exempting
3 the licenses from the selling agent fee; including the new
4 licenses in the license revenue recoupment program; and
5 providing for an effective date.

7 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8

9 **Section 1.** W.S. 23-1-504(a)(ii), 23-1-701(b)(i) and
10 23-2-101(j) by creating new paragraphs (xliv) and (xlv) are
11 amended to read:

13 **23-1-504. Free and reduced price license revenue**
14 **recoupment program.**

15

1 (a) Not later than July 31, 2007, and not later than
2 July 31 of each subsequent year thereafter, the chief
3 fiscal officer of the game and fish department shall
4 prepare and certify a report of licenses sold or issued in
5 the previous calendar year under the following statutes:

6
7 (ii) W.S. 23-2-101(j)(xi), (xvi), (xvii), (xx),
8 (xxi), (xxxii), ~~and~~ (xxxiii), (xliv) and (xlv);

9
10 **23-1-701. Selling agents; administration of oaths;**
11 **licenses, permits and game tags.**

12
13 (b) Each license selling agent shall charge a fee as
14 provided in this subsection for each license, permit or
15 stamp he sells or distributes pursuant to this act. The
16 fee shall not be charged if this act specifies that the
17 issuance shall be without fee or fails to establish a fee
18 for the issuance of the license, permit or stamp. Each
19 license, permit or stamp sold or distributed under this act
20 shall display the total amount only of all fees and other
21 charges required under this act or otherwise provided by
22 law. Each selling agent shall retain two dollars (\$2.00)
23 for each license and fifty cents (\$.50) for each stamp or
24 permit he sells. For failure to comply with this section,

1 selling agents shall not be entitled to retain the amounts
2 specified in this subsection and shall be liable on their
3 bond. No employee of the commission shall receive any
4 commission on licenses, stamps or permits sold, but the
5 department shall charge the additional fee specified in
6 this subsection, or otherwise provided by law, for each
7 license, stamp or permit sold by commission employees. The
8 fee charged under this subsection shall be in addition to
9 the amount otherwise established by this act for the
10 license, permit or stamp and shall be as follows:

11

12 (i) Two dollars (\$2.00) for each license, except
13 that this additional fee shall not be charged for licenses
14 under W.S. 23-1-705(e), 23-2-101(j)(xi), (xvi), (xvii),
15 (xx), (xxi), (xxxii), ~~or~~ (xliiv) or (xlv),
16 23-2-201(d)(iii) or (iv) or (f) or 23-2-301(c)(xiii);

18 **23-2-101. Fees; restrictions; nonresident application**
19 **fee; nonresident licenses; verification of residency**
20 **required.**

22 (j) Subject to W.S. 23-2-101(f), 23-1-705(e) and the
23 applicable fee under W.S. 23-1-701, the following hunting

1 licenses and tags may be purchased for the fee indicated
2 and subject to the limitations provided:

4 (xiv) Resident youth archery license..... 6.00

5

6 (xlv) Nonresident youth archery license.... 12.00

8 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2010.
