A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to workers' compensation; providing that
2 coverage for firefighters includes competition during
3 employer sanctioned training events and other ancillary
4 activities as specified; and providing for an effective
5 date.

7 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

9 **Section 1.** W.S. 27-14-108(a)(ii)(S)(I)(1)c.,
10 (e)(i)(E), (F) and by creating a new subparagraph (G) is
11 amended to read:

13 **27-14-108. Extrahazardous industries, employments,**
14 **occupations; enumeration; definitions; optional coverage.**

1 (a) This act applies to the following, which shall be
2 deemed extrahazardous employment:

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4 (ii) Regardless of individual occupation, all
5 workers employed in the following sectors, subsectors,
6 industry groups and industries, as each is defined in the
7 most recent edition of the North American Industry
8 Classification System (NAICS) manual:

10 (S) Public administration, sector 92:

12 (I) Subsector 922, justice, public
13 order and safety activities:

15 (1) Industry group 9221, justice,
16 public order and safety activities:

18 c. NAICS industry 92215,
19 fire protection, including firefighters while performing
20 under the direction of a duly authorized officer in charge
21 and engaged in competition at employer sanctioned training

23 equipment or facilities utilized in fire protection

1 activities, fundraising, civic affairs or other similar
2 authorized activities.
