

HOUSE BILL NO. HB0066

Water development projects-funding.

Sponsored by: Select Water Committee

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to water development; providing for the
2 funding of specified water projects; creating an account;
3 specifying use of the account; and providing for an
4 effective date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 99-99-1001(a) by creating a new
9 paragraph (viii), (k) and by creating a new subsection (m)
10 is amended to read:

12 **99-99-1001. Creation; use of funds; interest.**

14 (a) The following accounts are created:

15

16 (viii) Glendo reservoir account.

1 (k) Notwithstanding W.S. 41-2-1301(f), all revenues
2 received by the state from the lease, sale, assignment or
3 transfer of ownership of water resulting from the state's
4 interest in the Pathfinder modification project shall be
5 deposited in the account created by paragraph (a)(vii) of
6 this section. The Wyoming water development commission
7 shall use any monies in the account to meet the operation,
8 maintenance, replacement and mitigation obligations of the
9 state related to the Pathfinder modification project. Two
10 million two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$2,250,000.00)
11 from the appropriation from water development account II
12 provided in the 2000 Wyoming Session Laws, Chapter 36,
13 Section 6 is hereby transferred to the account created by
14 paragraph (a)(vii) of this section.

15

16 (m) All revenues received by the state from the
17 lease, sale, assignment or transfer of ownership of water
18 resulting from the state's interest in the Glendo reservoir
19 shall be deposited in the account created by paragraph
20 (a)(viii) of this section. The Wyoming water development
21 commission shall administer the account and use any monies
22 in the account to meet the operation, maintenance,
23 replacement and other contract obligations of the state
24 related to the Glendo reservoir water service contract.

1 Eight hundred thousand dollars (\$800,000.00) from the
2 appropriation from water development account I provided in
3 the 2002 Wyoming Session Laws, Chapter 83, Section 29 is
4 hereby transferred to the account created by paragraph
5 (a)(viii) of this section.

6

7 **Section 2.** This act is effective immediately upon
8 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
9 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
10 Constitution.
