Vehicle restoration.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to motor vehicles; amending provisions for
2 issuance of a title to a vehicle which requires restoration
3 as specified; and providing for an effective date.

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5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

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7 **Section 1.** W.S. 31-2-105 by creating a new subsection
8 (f) is amended to read:

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10 **31-2-105. Duplicate titles; affidavit of vehicle**
11 **ownership; bond for certificate of title.**

13 (f) If an applicant is applying for title to a
14 vehicle which he will restore for his own personal use,
15 title may be issued without a bond required by this section
16 if the applicant presents an affidavit of vehicle

1 ownership, a notarized bill of sale, a certified, written
2 statement of the value of the vehicle and a vehicle
3 identification number (VIN) inspection, at the time of
4 application. If the value of the vehicle cannot be
5 determined from any prior registration or title, the
6 applicant shall provide the county clerk the value of the
7 vehicle. The value of the vehicle shall be determined from
8 any current national appraisal guide, or the applicant may
9 elect to submit a certified written statement obtained from
10 a properly licensed Wyoming vehicle dealer stating the
11 appraised value of the vehicle. Any title issued under
12 this subsection shall state on its face that it is
13 nontransferable for one hundred eighty (180) days from the
14 date title issued.

16 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2011.
