Grand Teton National Park-transfer of state lands.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to state lands; directing that the interest
2 in certain state lands be transferred to the United States
3 Department of the Interior; providing terms for the
4 transfer; and providing for an effective date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8 **Section 1.**

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10 (a) The board of land commissioners is authorized to
11 convey all its right, title and interest in the following
12 described parcels of land within the boundaries of the
13 Grand Teton National Park to the United States Department
14 of the Interior:

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16 (i) All mineral rights owned by the state in the

1 parcel known as the Jackson Lake Parcel containing 39.59
2 acres, more or less, and being more particularly described
3 as: Section 36: Lot 6, Township 45 North, Range 115 West,
4 6th P.M., Teton County, WY;

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6 (ii) The parcel known as the Snake River Parcel
7 containing 86.32 acres, more or less, and being more
8 particularly described as: Section 16: Lots 2, 3, 4 and 7,
9 Township 42 North, Range 116 West, 6th P.M., Teton County,
10 WY;

12 (iii) The parcel known as the Antelope Flats
13 Parcel containing 640 acres, more or less, and being more
14 particularly described as: Section 16, Township 43 North,
15 Range 115 West, 6th P.M., Teton County, WY; and

16

17 (iv) The parcel known as the Kelly Parcel on Gros
18 Ventre Road containing 640 acres, more or less, and being
19 more particularly described as: Section 36, Township 43
20 North, Range 115 West, 6th P.M., Teton County, WY.

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22 (b) The conveyances authorized by subsection (a) of
23 this section shall be by sale at not less than appraised
24 value, with the terms of the sale to be determined by the

1 Board of Land Commissioners.

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3 (c) Proceeds from the sale shall be deposited to the
4 common school account within the permanent land fund.

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6 **Section 2.** This act is effective immediately upon
7 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
8 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
9 Constitution.
