

## HOUSE BILL NO. HB0208

Off-road vehicle registration-exemption.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to off-road vehicles; amending a  
2 definition; exempting off-road vehicles operated for  
3 agricultural purposes from registration requirements; and  
4 providing for an effective date.

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6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

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8 **Section 1.** W.S. 31-1-101(a)(x) and 31-2-707 by  
9 creating a new subsection (c) are amended to read:

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11 **31-1-101. Definitions.**

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13 (a) Except as otherwise provided, as used in this  
14 act:

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(x) "Implement of husbandry" means sheep wagons, portable livestock loading chutes and every vehicle designed and used exclusively for agricultural operations and only incidentally operated or moved upon the highways but includes any trailer only when being towed by a farm tractor and any off-road recreational vehicle when being operated for agricultural use, including but not limited to irrigation, fencing or moving livestock;

31-2-707. Exemptions.

(c) Off-road recreational vehicles, when being operated for agricultural use, including but not limited to irrigation, fencing or moving livestock, are exempt from this article.

**Section 2.** This act is effective immediately upon completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming Constitution.
