A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to the pari-mutuel commission; limiting
2 licensing of employees to those participating in pari-
3 mutuel wagering activities; increasing fining authority of
4 stewards; and providing for an effective date.

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6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

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8 **Section 1.** W.S. 11-25-104(f) and (g)(iii) is amended
9 to read:

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11 **11-25-104. Pari-mutuel commission; officers;**
12 **director; meetings; quorum; records; licenses generally;**
13 **effect of financial interest in events.**

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15 (f) Each permittee, participant and employee of a
16 permittee or participant who is directly involved in the

1 pari-mutuel wagering activities of the permittee or
2 participant shall be licensed by the commission and shall
3 comply with all rules and regulations and all orders issued
4 by the commission. No person shall hold any event with
5 pari-mutuel wagering without obtaining a permit.

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7 (g) The commission may delegate authority to enforce
8 rules of the commission and this act to three (3) stewards
9 at each pari-mutuel event, at least one (1) of whom shall
10 be an employee of and selected by the commission. The
11 commission shall require at least one (1) steward to
12 supervise each simulcast location that is approved by the
13 commission. Stewards shall exercise such reasonable and
14 necessary authority as is designated by rules of the
15 commission including the following:

17 (iii) Levy fines not to exceed ~~two hundred~~
18 ~~dollars (\$200.00)~~ one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) for
19 violations of rules of the commission. Violations shall be
20 reported daily and fines paid to the commission within
21 forty-eight (48) hours of imposition and notice;

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
