A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to professional services procurement;
2 providing for consideration of residency during the
3 professional services selection process; and providing for
4 an effective date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 9-2-1031(a) is amended to read:

10 **9-2-1031. Selection procedures.**

12 (a) For each proposed project, the principal
13 representative of the agency for which the project is
14 proposed shall evaluate current statements of
15 qualifications and performance data of firms on file with
16 the department or the agency, together with any

1 applications submitted by other qualified firms, and shall
2 select not less than three (3) firms considered qualified
3 to perform the required professional services.
4 Consideration in each selection process by the principal
5 representative shall be based upon the ability of
6 professional personnel, past performance, willingness to
7 meet time requirements, location, residency, current and
8 projected work loads, the volume of work previously awarded
9 to the firm by the agency, and the equitable distribution
10 of contracts among qualified firms. The agency shall
11 provide a complete description of the work to the firms
12 selected. These firms shall submit an unpriced proposal to
13 do the work.

15 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2011.
