National guard-billeted soldiers fund.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to the military; establishing a fund for
2 monies collected from soldier billeting operations;
3 specifying the use of monies in the fund; specifying
4 administration of the fund; requiring rulemaking; and
5 providing for an effective date.

7 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8

9 **Section 1.** W.S. 19-7-205 and 19-7-206 are created to
10 read:

11

12 **19-7-205.** Wyoming military department billeting
13 operations fund; corpus inviolate; investment by state
14 treasurer.

15

1 (a) A fund is established which shall be known as the
2 Wyoming military department billeting operations fund.

3

4 (b) Monies received from the operation of billeting
5 activities shall be transmitted to the state treasurer for
6 credit to the fund monthly and shall be invested by the
7 state treasurer as authorized under W.S. 9-4-715(a), (d)
8 and (e) in a manner designed to obtain the highest return
9 possible consistent with preservation of the transmitted
10 monies. Income and any interest earned from investment of
11 the fund shall be monthly credited by the state treasurer
12 to the fund and distributed in accordance with W.S.
13 19-7-206.

15 **19-7-206. Wyoming military department billeting**
16 **operations fund; uses of fund; administration; rulemaking.**

17

18 (a) Income and any interest earned from the billeting
19 operations fund created by W.S. 19-7-205 shall be
20 administered by the adjutant general.

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22 (b) Income and any interest earned in the billeting
23 operations fund shall be used only to operate day to day
24 billeting activities at Camp Guernsey for the benefit of

1 paying customers using chargeable quarters, including
2 personnel, cleaning, laundry and amenity services.

3

4 (c) No minimum balance is required to be maintained
5 in the fund. The fund may be drawn to a zero balance at
6 any time using normal approval processes for the movement
7 of monies.

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9 (d) The adjutant general shall promulgate rules and
10 regulations for the administration of the billeting
11 operations fund created by W.S. 19-7-205.

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13 **Section 2.** This act is effective immediately upon
14 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
15 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
16 Constitution.
