Military department-federally funded positions.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to the military department; authorizing the
2 adjutant general to create and fill authorized positions
3 that are fully reimbursed by federal funding; requiring
4 reporting; and providing for an effective date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 19-7-103(b) by creating a new
9 paragraph (xxii) is amended to read:

10

11 **19-7-103. Adjutant general; appointment; rank;**
12 **removal; duties and qualifications.**

14 (b) The adjutant general of Wyoming shall have powers
15 and duties and be paid a salary as follows:

16

1 (xxii) If the authority is specifically granted
2 by the legislature in its biennial budget, he may hire a
3 person to occupy a new or existing position of state
4 employment within the military department when federal
5 funds are received which reimburse the state of Wyoming for
6 one hundred percent (100%) of the cost of the position. In
7 the event that federal funding becomes unavailable to
8 maintain one hundred percent (100%) reimbursement for a
9 position filled pursuant to this paragraph, as determined
10 by the United States property and fiscal officer for
11 Wyoming, he shall eliminate the position. He shall report
12 to the legislature through the general government
13 appropriations process all positions that are created or
14 eliminated pursuant to this paragraph.

16 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2011.
